PUBLIC NOTICE

Local Rules Advisory Committee 2024 - 2026

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Missouri is authorized pursuant to statute and the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure to make Rules of Practice and Procedure governing bankruptcy cases and bankruptcy proceedings pending in this district. A Local Rules Advisory Committee ("LRAC") assists the Court in reviewing the present local rules, suggesting changes to the rules, and soliciting comments from the bar and the public concerning any proposed changes. Members of the LRAC are appointed to serve a three-year term. The most recent LRAC term concluded at the end of 2023. The Court will create a new LRAC for the 2024 through 2026 rules cycles.

Participants on the LRAC are tasked with attending at least one virtual meeting, with the possibility of a live meeting or additional virtual meetings as needed, beginning in April 2024. Participants on the LRAC should also be prepared to participate in semi-frequent email correspondence as questions and concerns related to the local rules arise during the rules making process.

Individuals interested in serving on the LRAC for the 2024 through 2026 rules cycles should write to LRAC@moeb.uscourts.gov between January 8, 2024, and February 7, 2024, expressing their interest. The LRAC is chaired and coordinated by Matthew Rodman, Attorney Advisor to the Clerk of Court. Any questions concerning the LRAC can be submitted to attorney_advisor@moeb.uscourts.gov. All individuals expressing interest will be thoroughly considered by the Clerk's Office and our panel of judges at a Judges' Meeting in February 2024. Selected individuals will be notified about their selection by the first week of March 2024.
