Changes to the Reaffirmation Agreement Events and Other Reminders

The Court has modified three Reaffirmation Agreement events in the CM/ECF database. The events were modified to include questions to assist the Filer in selecting the correct reaffirmation agreement event.

Below, please find an outline describing the purpose for each of the reaffirmation agreement event codes:

REAFFIRMATION AGREEMENT EVENT CODE	PURPOSE
Reaffirmation (Unsigned) has changed to: Reaffirmation Agreement (Unsigned by Debtor's Attorney)	Use this event code when the reaffirmation agreement has been signed by the debtor(s) and the creditor; however, the reaffirmation agreement is not signed by the debtor's attorney. A proposed order is not needed with the filing of any reaffirmation agreement.
Reaffirmation / Redemption Agreement	Use this event code when the debtor(s), creditor and attorney have all signed the Reaffirmation Agreement, and Part E: Motion for Court Approval <u>is not a part of the document</u> . A proposed order is not needed with the filing of any reaffirmation agreement.
Reaffirmation Agreement and Motion to Approve	Use this event code when the debtor(s) and creditor have signed the Reaffirmation Agreement <u>and</u> Part E: Motion for Court Approval is signed. A proposed order is not needed with the filing of any reaffirmation agreement. Please note: You may also use this event if the Reaffirmation Agreement is unsigned by Debtor's Attorney and Part E: Motion for Court Approval is signed.

CM/ECF has a “**Search**” tab located in the blue tab bar at the top of the page. This search feature allows you to search all events for all case types by typing a word, a phrase, or a few letters of a word.

CM/ECF Training: The Court continues to provide training for new users of CM/ECF. We offer separate training classes for debtor and creditor users.
